



Today's Hard Target Focus: Sliding Glass Doors



Residential burglaries are increasing, as is typical for the warmer weather months. But - I have noticed a significant increase in sliding glass doors being shattered in order for the burglar to gain entry into a home.

This use to be an unusual method of entry for burglars due to the amount of noise it makes, and because a slider doesn't always break away clean from the frame. But it's obvious, especially based upon recent numbers, that this method of entry is growing in popularity.

Those of you who have attended a Block Watch meeting have heard me mention that there are two things you want to keep in mind when it comes to deterring criminal activity: 1) You want to make it very uncomfortable for the criminal, and 2) You want to make it very inconvenient for them.

There aren't many options to assist in protecting your sliding glass door from being shattered, but there *are* a few and I strongly encourage you to consider them:

- 1) **Security Doors:** There are a few options out there for security doors for sliding glass doors (similar to storm or security doors commonly installed in front of pedestrian doors). Use your research skills on the internet or visit your local hardware store to find out what would work best for your sliding glass door.
- 2) **Security Film:** This is a thin polyester film that is attached to existing glass. If glass coated with security film is hit with force (like a brick, rock, bat, etc.,) the glass may eventually shatter in a fan pattern, out from the point of impact, much like a shattered car windshield. But the film will hold the glass pieces together and in place. In most cases, the impact will not result in a hole in the glass unless excessive or continuous force is used.. Or check with your local glass company to see if they have a professional installer at their location. They can give you a free estimate.
- 3) **Alarm System:** Burglars don't like alarms, and they also don't like the thought that there might be an alarm in the house. Gone are the days of having to have an alarm professionally installed. There are plenty of independent contractors out there who can install an audible alarm system in your home. Or - if you're handy - you can install one yourself. It's not very often a home is targeted when there is an alarm installed.

Remember: There are no guarantees. But if you layer your defense "mechanisms" when it comes to protecting your home, your chances of being targeted for burglary decrease.
